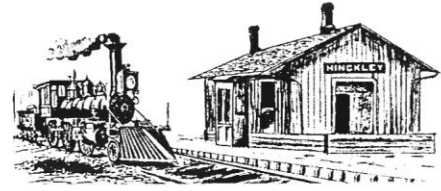

BRUSH PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF POLICY

Effective: April 1, 2011

Brush Pick Up

Brush pick up takes place on the 1st Monday of each month from April through the first Monday in October. When a holiday falls on a scheduled pickup day, pick up will occur the following Tuesday. Branches should be stacked not bundled, near the curb or edge of the street, with the cut ends facing one direction. Stumps, root balls, or root systems will **not** be collected. Limbs and branches exceeding 4" in diameter will not be collected. Foreign material items, such as construction debris, fence posts, lumber, wire, grass/grass clippings or other yard waste will **not** be collected. This program is intended for the disposal of limbs and branches removed by the property owner for normal maintenance and upkeep only, not for lot clearing or the removal of trees and shrubs. The Village will not pick up material produced under these conditions, or material produced by a contractor.

Brush Drop Off

Brush drop off will now be offered as a convenience to the residents of Hinckley. Brush may be dropped off at the Maintenance Department at 200 S. East Sandwich Rd. Hours of Brush Drop Off are 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on Saturdays only (EXCLUDING HOLIDAYS). If the Public Works employee on duty does not know you, he will ask for proof of residency. Items accepted are: stumps, brush, root balls, root systems, bushes, branches (of any size). Absolutely **no** construction debris, fence posts, lumber, wire, grass or grass clippings, leaves, or any other yard waste will be accepted. Contractor-removed debris will be accepted, but the contractor must show proof of residency of the owner. (Such as a paid, signed and dated invoice from the homeowner, stating the address of removal.) **This program is not intended for lot clearing.**

Leaf Pickup

Leaves will be picked up from late October through the end of November. Leaves should be piled near the street, in a wide row or pile, and **not** placed in the gutter. They may **not** be placed in bags or boxes. Leaf piles must be clean of grass clippings, plastic, wood and other trash or they will **not** be picked up. Leaf pick up will be on Mondays and continue until all areas of the Village have been collected.

NOTE: Yardwaste stickers for leaf and brush pickup may be purchased at Village Hall for weekly pick up by Waste Management April through November.
